The meeting started presentation from Dr. Sharad Sharma, Senior Demographer, FHD which included the following contents:

- 1. Implementation status of MPDSR
- 2. Update on MPDSR from districts implementing MPDSR
- 3. Activities planned for coming year
- 4. Challenges for implementing MPDSR

The draft hardcopy of the following documents were also shared with the TWG for review and feedback:

This was followed by discussion in the TWG with following recommendations:

Recommendations:

- Mobilization of the participants of the trainer's training of hospital MPDSR for on-site coaching at MPDSR implementing hospitals
- Separate session on MPDSR during coming RH Review meeting
- Focal person for MPDSR to be strengthened at hospitals and districts with on-site coaching, frequent communications, support from existing human resource such as clinical nurses (for PHN) and External Development Partners (EDPs)

- Close coordination between FHD and MD (QI Section) for strengthening of the program and quality of services at local level
- Coordination of MPDSR Committees and QI committees at facility and district levels for implementation of action plans developed by review of maternal and perinatal deaths
- Include NSI in the MPDSR TWG for support at national and district levels
- Coordinate MPDSR program with CHD in districts where newborn death surveillance is implemented (Solukhumbu, Kailali)
- Empower DHO to support in implementation of MPDSR at districts where only hospital MPDSR is implemented with support from External Development Partners
- FHD to evaluate regarding effectiveness of action plans recommended by MPDSR committees at different levels
- MPDSR districts can implement innovative actions to prevent maternal deaths within the budget available from MPDSR at district levels with approval from FHD
- NESOG members are ready to be involved in the activities to support implementation of MPDSR at hospital level
- Integration of MPDSR with other FHD guidelines for more wider dissemination and strengthening
- Revision of newborn care protocol for inclusion of Inj. Vit K
- Share "Free Newborn Care" Guideline and orient at sites for effective implementation
